A fast moving exploration of all the major sites featured in the Gospels. Starting with the Annunciation, David Nunn follows the Gospel drama chronologically, providing fascinating and illuminating insights into the life of Christ - and incidentally, into the history of Israel.

- VC501 **THE MIRACLE MAKER [DVD]**
3D model animation combined with graphically striking 2D animation in this new portrayal of the life of Jesus, told through the eyes of a child.
- VC502 **THE JESUS QUEST [DVD]**
The trouble starts when Benjamin and his friends join the crowds to find out what's really happening with the new miracle man, Jesus. His dad doesn't want Benjamin to have anything to do with Jesus, but the six friends can't wait to see what he'll do next. But as they get closer to the action, things go from bad to worse, and they have no idea what's around the corner.
- VC504 **ANIMATED BIBLE STORIES: THE LIFE OF JESUS [DVD]**
Stories of key moments in the life of Christ and the story of Jesus. The First Christmas - How Mary & Joseph felt when they first heard the news that Mary was to become the mother of the Son of God. The events leading up to Jesus' birth, through to the flight to Egypt. Jesus the Storyteller - the role of the disciples and the way in which Jesus taught people about God. - VC512 **THE KING IS BORN [DVD]**
30 minutes The story of the nativity. The Angel Gabriel: God's messenger appears to Mary, having already appeared to Joseph in a dream.
The Census: the Roman's announce a census. Mary and Joseph leave for Bethlehem. A King is Born: Jesus is born in the stable. The angels appear to the shepherds. Rejoice: The shepherds arrive at the stable. As the star shines brightly, the Wise Men prepare to leave. Herod's Wrath: Jesus' presentation at the Temple. The Wise Men alert Herod to the birth of a new King. Three Wise Men: the arrival of the Wise Men at Bethlehem.
- VC531 **THE MIRACLES OF JESUS [DVD]**
Beginning with the appearance of John the Baptist, the DVD then follows the course of Jesus' ministry, in 5 easily accessible sections. Events covered are: Jesus' baptism, the parable of the sower and the seed; the miraculous catch of fish; the calling of the first disciples; the wedding at Cana; the healing of a leper; the calming of the storm; the paralysed man lowered through the roof; the call of Matthew; the healing of Jairus' daughter; the woman with the issue of blood; the parable of the prodigal son; the feeding of the 5000; Jesus walking on water; the raising of Lazarus. Charlton Heston also tells the whole story, in a separate section.
- VC533 **THE MIRACLES OF JESUS [DVD]**
30 minutes. The Sanhedrin sends a spy to expose Jesus' miracles as fraudulent. Seeking Jesus: Jairus' daughter meets a boy born palsied, whose parents are taking him to Jesus. The woman with an issue of blood decides is desperate. Master Help Me: Jairus' daughter becomes ill. The woman with an issue of blood decides to seek Jesus. As his daughter's condition worsens, Jairus too seeks Jesus. The palsied boy is healed. Jairus' daughter dies. Your Faith: The healing of the woman with the issue of blood. The healing of Jairus' daughter. Walking on Water: as Jesus rejoins his disciples in the boat by walking over the water, Peter tries to emulate him. The Miracle of Love: many miracles are briefly shown, including the healing at the pool of Siloam, the healing of the blind man, the healing of the man with a withered arm, etc. But as the talk about Jesus intensifies, the greatest miracle is still the miracle of love.
- VC535 **LAZARUS LIVES [DVD]**
30 mins. Jesus Heals: as Jesus comforts a widow, Lazarus and his sisters confront their fear of death. Lazarus helps an old friend who is a leper. Come With Me: Lazarus witnesses Jesus' healing of a man with a withered hand. A True Friend: Lazarus courageously takes the leper to be healed by Jesus. Jesus becomes a friend to Lazarus and his family. Lazarus Dies: when Lazarus becomes ill, Mary sends for Jesus. Jesus is under attack from his enemies, and refuses to give them a sign of his Messiah-ship, except for the sign of Jonah. I Shall Rise Again: Lazarus dies and is buried. Jesus predicts his death and Resurrection. Mary's messenger arrives, but Jesus knows Lazarus is dead. The disciples are worried about his plans to return to Jerusalem, because of the prediction. Lazarus Lives: Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life.
- VC540 **JESUS, THE SON OF GOD [DVD]**
30 mins. Starting with the visit as a boy with his family to Jerusalem (introduction), this DVD shows episodes from the life of Jesus, the Son of God. Jesus is Lost: as his parents leave Jerusalem they realise that Jesus is not with them.
The Grace of God: Jesus grows in the grace of God, helping others, praying, helping Mary to mourn for Joseph, working as a

carpenter, leaving home, and being baptised.

40 Days & 40 Nights: Jesus is driven into the wilderness, where, fasting and praying, he meets satan.

Temptations: the story of the temptations.

VC541 **LORD, I BELIEVE [DVD]**

Running time: 30 minutes Four miracles of Jesus' The Sick servant; Lord, I Believe; and Healed tell the story of the healing of the Centurion's servant. Have Faith tells the story of the Widow's son at Nain. Healing the Blind & Casting Out tell the intertwined stories of the healing of two blind men, and the healing of the epileptic boy.

VC542 **PEOPLE WHO MET JESUS Series 1 [DVD]**

8 short dramas of people in the Gospels who encountered Jesus. A resource for Bible study, small groups and Sunday School.

VC543 **PEOPLE WHO MET JESUS Series 2 [DVD]**

Understand the events leading up to the death and resurrection of Jesus through the eyes of the people involved, 8 people who met Jesus. £ of them became his disciples, but all were impacted by his life and message.

VC544 **TREASURES IN HEAVEN [DVD]**

30 minutes. The contrasting stories of the rich young ruler, Zacchaeus, and blind Bartimaeus. A Greedy Man: the rich young ruler arrives in Jerusalem. Greedy Zacchaeus forces blind Bartimaeus to pay his taxes. Entering Heaven: the rich young ruler hears Jesus teaching. Jesus blesses the children. The ruler asks Jesus what he must do to be saved. Jesus explains how difficult it is for a rich man to enter the Kingdom. I Must See Jesus: Bartimaeus tells Zacchaeus about Jesus. The Healing of Bartimaeus. Remorse: Jesus sees Zacchaeus in the tree, and visits his house. Treasures from Heaven: a party at Zacchaeus' house. Zacchaeus is a changed man. Jesus teaches about real treasure.

VC550 **THE LORD'S PRAYER [DVD]**

The story of Peter's arrest in Jerusalem after the Resurrection is the vehicle for a recap of Jesus' teaching on prayer. There are CB flashbacks to the Sermon on the Mount (The Lord's Prayer), the parable of the man demanding bread of his friend in the middle of the night, the parable of the unjust judge, and the prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane.

VC551 **JOHN THE BAPTIST [DVD]**

VC560 **THE PARABLES OF JESUS [DVD]**

Running time: 30 minutes. 3 parables told by Jesus. The introduction & The Two Sons tell the story of the two sons, one of whom promised his father he would help but did not; one of whom refused to help, but did. The Rich Man & It's Too Late tell the story of the rich man and Lazarus. The Talents; Working Hard; & A Waste of Time tell the story of the Talents.

VC562 **THE PRODIGAL SON [DVD]**

Running time: 30 minutes

VC563 **THE LOST IS FOUND [DVD]**

30 minutes. 3 sinners come to Jesus. Death is Near: the story of the friends who lowered a sick man (Jonah) through a roof for healing. The Greedy Collectors: the call of Matthew. The story of Miriam the harlot, who is helped by Jonah. The parable of the lost coin. Escape!: Miriam's escape plan is foiled. Jesus tells the parable of the lost sheep. Come With Me: Jesus is invited to the home of Simon the Pharisee. Miriam washes Jesus' feet with her tears. Jesus tells the parable of the 2 debtors. Miriam joins Jonah - in freedom.

VC564 **THE RIGHTEOUS JUDGE [DVD]**

30 minutes The story is set against Jesus' teachings about not judging others. The Law: the man born blind wants his parents to find Jesus. The woman taken in adultery is brought before Caiaphas. There are rumours that Jesus is the real religious leader of Israel, not Caiaphas. Arrest Him!: Jesus is accused of healing on the Sabbath. He warns his accusers of judging others. He knows they want to arrest him. Caiaphas plots to show Jesus up as unrighteous. He Who is Without Sin: the Jews bring the woman taken in adultery before Jesus, hoping to catch him out. I Can See: Nicodemus witnesses Jesus heal the man born blind. I Seek the Lord: with his sight restored, the man born blind searches for Jesus.

VC565 **BUILT UPON THE ROCK [DVD]**

Running time: 30 minutes. Some parables and sayings of Jesus are interwoven with the story of the two brothers whose inheritance Jesus refuses to judge between. Listen to Jesus: the younger brother is told not to listen to his lawyers but to Jesus as he gives the Sermon on the Mount. Built upon a Rock: the parable of the house built on a rock. Dishonesty: the younger brother tries to put Jesus' teachings into practice with his elder brother, but his brother fails to respond. Greed: the elder brother's plans to get rich become worse. A Fool's Treasure: the parable of the Rich Fool.

VC566 **SIGNS OF THE TIMES [DVD]**

30 minutes. As Jesus approaches Jerusalem, the disciples are still confused about his ministry. In the Temple, Jesus explains to them about the end times. The Kingdom of Heaven: the parable of the wedding feast. All Are Welcome: the end of the parable of the wedding feast. Great Sorrow: Jesus predicts the destruction of the Temple. He warns his bewildered disciples about imposters and signs in the heavens. The parable of the thief in the night. The Foolish Man: the end of the parable of the thief in the night. Watch and Be Ready: Jesus warns his disciples that they must remain alert. He again predicts his death and resurrection. The disciples confess their belief in him.

VC567 **THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN [DVD]**

30 mins. Jesus teaches in parables which help us learn what the Kingdom of Heaven is like, and how we should live each day. The DVD begins with the parable of the sheep and the goats. The crowd wonder why he teaches them with stories which only some of them understand and they are divided in their response to the parables. Jesus tells the story of the wheat and the weeds. The Pearl: the parable of the pearl of great price. Give Up All I Have: the parable of the pearl troubles one ambitious young man, and he leaves the crowd surrounding Jesus. Jesus explains that many are called but few are chosen. He tells the parable of the wise and foolish virgins. True Friends Hear My Call: the end of the parable of the wise and foolish virgins. Jesus explains to the disciples why he teaches in parables. He begins the parable of the sheep and the goats. The Kingdom of Heaven: the DVD ends, as it began, with the parable of the sheep and the goats.

VC568 **FORGIVE US OUR DEBTS [DVD]**

30 minutes Peter is accosted by some rude tax collectors who want the annual Temple tribute from him and Jesus. They make

him very angry. Jesus tells him he will find a coin in the mouth of a fish to pay the tribute, and proceeds to teach Peter about forgiveness. The Foolish Man; No Mercy & Punishment tell the parable of the unforgiving servant. How to Forgive?: Peter wrestles all night with the implications of Jesus' teaching. Forgiveness: The tax collectors wreck Peter's nets, but he has learned the lesson of forgiveness and passes it on to his son.

VC569 **THE GOOD SAMARITAN [DVD]**

Running time: 30 minutes

VC573 **GOD'S LOVE STORYTELLING KIT [DVD]**

Set in box, containing 1 interactive CDRpm, 1 storyteller booklet and 1 operator booklet. There are 4 stories, demonstrating how wide, high and deep God's love is: Cecil the Lost Sheep, The Good Samaritan, Zac the Taxman, and Jonah and the Whale. The CDRom has the pictures from the books, to display on screen, as you tell the story. There is no sound on the CDRom. Big Books are available for some of the stories.

VC575 **PARABLES FOR KIDS [DVD]**

Shema Old Testament stories (30 mins) Animated version of 10 well-known parables (4 mins each) The sower, The prodigal son, The good Samaritan, The pharisee & the tax collector, The lost sheep The talents, The good shepherd, The lost coin, The man with 2 sons, The house built on rock.

VC580 **BREAD FROM HEAVEN [DVD]**

30 minutes The overarching story is of a young street urchin, begging for food, whose precious bread is stolen from him by a gang of bullies. Hearing that Jesus is in the area, he goes to find out whether what he hears of Jesus is true. I Need Bread: the young beggar is reluctantly given bread by a baker, and hears about Jesus. Teaching the Crowd: The beggar follows the crowd to where Jesus is arriving by boat. The disciples are still excited about the healing of Jairus' daughter. Jesus performs many miracles and teaches the crowd. The Feeding of the 5000. Feeding Thousands: During the miraculous meal, the baker & his cronies come up with a plot to make Jesus king, so they will never have to work again. To avoid this, Jesus sends his disciples away and leaves the crowd. Walking on Water: Jesus joins the disciples during a terrible storm. I am the Bread: the plotters arrive at a synagogue where Jesus is teaching. Jesus makes it clear he will never be their kind of king. He teaches about himself as the true bread from heaven. The plotters abandon him, but the disciples refuse to do so, as they believe he is the Christ, the Son of the Living God. The beggar also believes, and has learned to share his bread - and his faith in Jesus.

VC596 **HE IS RISEN [DVD]**

30 minutes Jesus is dead, but the greatest miracle of all is yet to happen. Live or Die: the disciples are behind locked doors for fear of the Jews. Joseph of Arimathea asks Pilate for permission to bury Jesus' body. The Sabbath Begins: Joseph and Nicodemus bury the body. Caiaphas asks Pilate for a guard for the tomb. Angels of God: early on Sunday morning, while it's still dark, the guards are awakened by an earthquake. The tombstone cracks open. The guards faint with terror at the vision of angels. The tomb is filled with light. Mary meets the angels. He's Gone: Peter and John arrive at the tomb. Mary meets the gardener. Jesus is alive! He is Risen: the guards report to Caiaphas and are bribed to remain silent about what happened. The story of Doubting Thomas. The disciples meet Jesus while fishing on Lake Galilee.

VC597 **THE MESSIAH COMES [DVD]**

30 minutes. In the final weeks of Jesus' life, his disciples struggle to understand his mission, and plots and rumours abound. A young Jewish man, suffering under Roman oppression, tries to work out who Jesus really is. Den of Thieves: Jesus overturns the tables of the moneylenders in the Temple. Plotting Revenge: the Sanhedrin argue about Jesus' identity. Nicodemus meets Jesus at night, and then writes to Cleopas to tell him about Jesus' miraculous escape from the mob when he preached at Capernaum. Miracles: the healing at the pool of Bethesda. Nicodemus describes various other miracles and teachings. Jerusalem: the triumphant entry into Jerusalem. Questioning of Jesus' authority. Healing of a man with a withered hand. The Messiah: the parable of the tenants in the vineyard. Nicodemus realises that Jesus is a different kind of Messiah to the one he had expected. The arrest of Jesus. The Crucifixion. Jesus Has Risen: after the Crucifixion, Nicodemus buys spices to bury Jesus. The story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus.

VC598 **THE GREATEST IS THE LEAST [DVD]**

30 minutes. In the years following the Resurrection, the disciples learn to follow Jesus' lessons about serving others. Arrest Him: The Apostle James is arrested. Agrippa is determined to use his power to become the greatest of all the local kings. He sends James to the salt mines and threatens him with execution. I am the Greatest: in the salt mines, James witnesses 2 rival co-workers fight in rivalry to become lieutenant to a recently promoted overseer. James remembers when the disciples asked Jesus which of them was the greatest. He told them they had to become humble and like little children. He also remembers when the disciples wanted to call down fire from heaven on a city which refused to welcome Jesus. Jesus told them he did not come to destroy. We Should Be First: James remembers when Jesus predicted his Passion. The disciples did not understand because they believed he would become king. A Greedy King: Agrippa and his chamberlain both want more power and recognition of their greatness. In the salt mine, the 2 co-workers outdo each other to show their worthiness of promotion. James remembers the Last Supper, when Jesus washed the disciples' feet. The Greatest is the Least: Agrippa orders James' execution. During a great feast, as he is honoured and acclaimed by other kings, Agrippa dies. James, led out to die, is honoured by heaven.

VC599 **WORTHY IS THE LAMB [DVD]**

30 minutes The Passion of Christ, interspersed with the prophecies fulfilled by unfolding events. Judas: Mary anoints Jesus' feet. Judas complains about this waste. Jesus sends his disciples to find a colt for him to ride on. Betrayal: Judas betrays Jesus to the Jewish leaders. Stay With Me: the garden of Gethsemane. Charges Against Jesus: Peter denies Jesus three times. The trial before Caiaphas. Crucify Him: the trial before Pilate. The crowd choose Barabbas to be released. The mockery of the Roman soldiers. Jesus is taken to be crucified. It Is Finished: the Crucifixion. The death of Judas is reported. As Jesus dies, there is a bright rent in the dark clouds, promising hope.

VC600 **THE APOSTLES [DVD]**

Beginning with the healing by Peter of the cripple at the Gate Beautiful, the DVD tells the story of Acts, in 5 easily accessible sections. Charlton Heston also tells the story, in a separate section.

VC601 **SAUL OF TARSUS [DVD]**

30 minutes. The story of St. Paul. The Trial: the trial and death of Stephen, with Saul watching. Under Arrest: Saul hunts

Christians in Jerusalem. Do Your Job: on his way to Damascus, Paul encounters Jesus and is struck blind. God's Calling: God tells Ananias to go to Saul and heal him. Hiding Away: Saul changes his name to Paul. Because Caiaphas is now hunting him, he escapes from Damascus by being let down over the walls in a basket. The Right Reasons: a brief overview of Paul's later career, up to his death in Rome.

VC602 **THE MINISTRY OF PAUL [DVD]**

Running time: 30 minutes. Set against a backdrop of opposition from the Jews, the DVD tells the story of Paul's later ministry: Have Faith: Paul and Silas in jail in Philippi. Against the Law: Paul in Athens. God Saved Me: Paul in Jerusalem - and prison again. Blasphemy: Paul is sent to Caesarea, to stand trial before Herod.

It is suggested that the Steps to Freedom in Christ course is fitted in between sessions 9 and 10, possibly as an Away Day, though other options are given. The course is reasonably flexible, designed not to be legalistic. but very fundamentalist, with some questionable pastoral issues which any church considering doing this course would do well to consider.

VD034 **STEPS TO FREEDOM IN CHRIST [DVD]**

Presented by Steve Goss, Director of Freedom in Christ Ministries. To be used as part of 'The Freedom in Christ Discipleship Course', DVDA-A035. The seven steps are a structured tool in the process of resolving and repenting in the spiritual conflict, but this should not lead to legalism, as Jesus has already done all that needs to be done, except for our repentance.

There is hope for a better tomorrow. We can learn from his mistakes that there is always more.

VD040 **A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE [DVD]**

4 session DVD, for group and individual Bible study, set against the background of the Madejsky football stadium in Reading: 1. The passionate God. The Book of Jonah shows us the Big God, not the big fish - a God who is close up and involved, sometimes with the most unexpected people. 2. Life after failure. This takes humility, and the willingness never to allow bitterness into our hearts, but be willing instead to hand it all over to God to work out in his own good time. Friendship is great - it can be such hard work! but it's worth fighting for! 3. Falling Out: Paul and Barnabas were such different men, and they eventually fell out with each other. This was a collision of gifts, a gift war. We should be quick to listen to each other, and slow to speak, and willing to change, because that's how we maintain our relationships. Don't forget to slow down or relationships can shatter. No-one is totally right all the time, and we should never use our giftings as if they were weapons. We need humility in friendship. 4. Friendship that Builds: Paul poured out his understanding of life into others, especially Timothy. We all need to mentor and be mentored. We need authentic discipleship. Paul wanted Jesus, not Paul, to be formed in Timothy, because Timothy has a destiny of his own which is unique to him. He could release Timothy into his own destiny because he held him in respect. That's what we all need to do. But Paul was a good balancing influence on Timothy when needed, and he prayed for his friend and followed up the prayers with real commitment. Who are we investing in? Who's

investing in us?

VD042 **SINGING IN THE RAIN [DVD]**

Growth comes only as we doubt and question and wrestle with our faith. After each section, there is a participant's guide for discussion and debate., with 4 people giving their views on the topic.

Our heart is our most valuable gift; that's why we have to be careful who and what we give it to.

Only God is worthy of worship. 3. Don't mis-use the name of God. Lance's purpose in life is to separate you from your money - and he's good at it. He's worked out a way to stop the profits of a company producing bottled water plummeting: re-name the water 'God Water' - totally pure, totally reliable, and so cheap to market! The following talk tells us we mis-use God's name whenever we use it in a way that benefits us but has nothing to do with Him. In its way, it's mocking God. And it's a dangerous game! 4. Keep the Sabbath. Parents hear of their son's death in a traffic accident. Things they meant to do but failed to do; but now he's dead. If only their son had slowed down! Will we stop and slow down? Are we overwhelmed by life? God wants to train us to stop and sharpen our blades. It makes us more productive in the end. It was good for God! Great for us! 5. Honour your father and mother. Cheryl has been a poor mother because of her alcohol addiction. Can her daughter forgive her and allow her to become a good grandmother? If we honour God, we should honour our parents. But honouring imperfect people is not easy. God has the perfect mix of directing us and connecting with us. We all wish our parents were different, but God calls us to honour them in the midst of their imperfections. No-one is perfect but God. Extras: Liquid promo; What is Liquid?; Behind the scenes; Liquid trailers.

Her hold over Ortis, the cryogenics specialist, was his accidental murder of someone participating in the cryogenic experiment. In remorse, Ortis commits suicide. We may not all murder someone, but our attitudes can kill relationships, reputations, etc. 7. Adultery. The stalker of Spencer, is undergoing counselling. The tale of her adulterous relationship with Spencer emerges. She has had his baby, This relationship has destroyed his marriage and his reputation and his life. The commandment to not commit adultery is teaching us how to live. Joseph's story shows us how to cope with our feelings: create distance between you and the one tempting you. 8. Stealing. The singer whose son died in a traffic accident wants his son to be remembered: he wants his son's last recorded song to be a hit. The man who created God water persuades him to pretend the song is his, written in his son's memory. The story of Jacob and Esau shows how easy it is to steal: a child's joy, or a person's reputation or dignity. 9. Testifying falsely. The God water man is Angelica's heir. He wants Ortis to testify to her death so that he can inherit. A tale of blackmail, and those who tell the truth and those who don't. Breathing is so normal, yet it is a symbol of a deeper spiritual reality. Biblically, breath also means spirit. This is the dilemma at the core of what makes us human: the power and strength implicit in being made in the image of God, is in contrast to our vulnerability and fragility. To better understand how God created us as humans, we need more insight into the meaning of breathing. 14 mins.
- VD215 **NOOMA - YOU [DVD]**
First century Christians saw themselves as an alternative society to that of the Roman Empire. They adopted the terminology of Roman propaganda, but used it to further their hope of the renewal and reclamation of this world. People were free to choose between Caesar's claims that he could make a new world by force, and the Christian claim that a new world could be created by loving acts of generosity. Who was making a better world? Early Christians were fierce with reality. People felt compelled to ask why Christians were the way they were; why they made you feel they'd been with Jesus, and God hadn't given up on the world; why they made you feel that God wanted to put your own brokenness back together again. Now, WE are the Gospel. If our lives were the only proof that Jesus rose from the dead, would non-believers believe?
- VD216 **NOOMA - STORE [DVD]**
We get angry about a lot of things, but why? What's it really all about? What's the root cause?
If we could channel our rage into something constructive, perhaps we could learn to use it for a cause that's bigger than we are.
- VD217 **NOOMA - TODAY [DVD]**
How much time do we spend wishing things were as they used to be? Are our best years behind us? Would we really go back to the past? When we're stuck in the past, it can lead to despair. We all compare ourselves to others, wonder what others think of us, allow others' expectations to dictate what we become. Are

Why does prayer work sometimes and not other times? Does God answer prayer? Sometimes but not others? Does He say 'No'? Where is God when nothing happens? Why doesn't an all-powerful God do everything we ask? Why bother to pray if God does what He wants? Rob Bell takes a look at Jesus' prayer in Gethsemane. Jesus takes seriously the Genesis Creation poem. In Genesis, God creates all things, but leaves all things to reproduce themselves. This means that creation is in some ways unfinished, because we are invited to take part in the on-going creation of the world. Creation is a risk, but God worked to make order out of chaos, and we are invited to tap into the creative energy which made all things. This means being open to the God at work here and now. Prayer is about being brutally honest with God. In Gethsemane, Jesus assumes he is involved in the ongoing work of creation. So are we. We may be the answer to someone's prayer.

Prayer is about our whole posture to life, about being still, listening, waking up to what God is up to here and now, and how we can be open to it. Prayer is about tapping into the energy which made the universe and connects us to each other and changes us. We may not understand how and why prayer works or not, but we must be open to our role in the ongoing creation of the world.

VD221 **NOOMA - SHE [DVD]**

Motherhood gives us a good picture of what God is like. But sometimes, this part of God's nature is overlooked, because many of us are uncomfortable with female imagery of God. But is God limited to gender? Maybe, if we were more aware of the feminine imagery for God, we would have a better understanding of who God is and what God is like.

VD222 **NOOMA - TOMATO [DVD]**

It is a life principle that our life depends on something else dying, like a tomato for example, which is dead when we eat it. This principle of life from death is part of the very fabric of creation. Jesus by his death and resurrection teaches us how to die so that we can really live. We all have a deep part of us which is pre-occupied with looking good, with twisting words and situations to make ourselves look better, with a false self-image we have deliberately created.

We are too concerned with others' perception of ourselves. The world has taught us false ideas of where our value and worth and acceptance lie. This deep part of us needs to die if we are to really find true life. Rather than the path of ascent which our society encourages us to follow, Jesus teaches the path of descent, the path where we have to lose life in order to find it. Saying sorry is a form of death. But the time and effort involved in maintaining a particular version of yourself can be better used, and the fears rooted in what other people think of you will disappear once we know we are already loved and accepted, because of Jesus not because we are good enough. This is how Jesus saves.

VD223 **NOOMA - CORNER [DVD]**

When times are tough and resources scarce, it's easy to be grateful for everything we have. We can have an acute and ever-present awareness of life as a gift. But when we become successful, we lose that gratitude somewhere along the way. Success can be dangerous. When we gain everything, we can lose something we had before. Deuteronomy instructs the Jews to leave the gleanings in their fields, for people like widows and refugees to collect. They were given this instruction in the Wilderness, because God was telling them that life would not always be Wilderness. Some day, when life changed, they would forget what it was like to experience liberation. When they came to think it unfair that some of their harvest should go to people who did not work for it, they were instructed to remember that being liberated from slavery wasn't fair, either. Redemption is not fair. God is not fair. God was warning them what would happen when they lost their sense of appreciation and gratitude. By expressing grace undeserved to others, we can rediscover what God has done for us. If we don't seek and find suffering and do something about it, we ourselves can become miserable, because we forget what we've been given. We are saved from indifference and inertia when we extend to others the unfairness we ourselves have experienced. And we find that they have what we needed all along!

VD301 **FACING THE UNTHINKABLE [DVD]**

Devised and written by David and Pauline Pearson. Using the media of video, role play and information sheets, and by working in small discussion groups and larger plenary sessions, the course explores the nature of child abuse, its signs and symptoms and the way in which safe strategies can be put into place in local churches. It gives advice on dealing with outside agencies such as social services and police. The course is intended for youth and children's workers over 16 (due to the nature of the seminar), those with child protection responsibilities, house group leaders, nursery workers, play groups, parent toddler groups, camp workers and other leaders in churches and children's organisations. It is divided into three sessions which include watching the video section, discussion and then questions based on the video. Pentecost. A historical drama about the people who owned the house where the Pentecost experience took place, and how they 'saw' it. 8. Following Directions: themes of the Holy Spirit, listening to God, sharing faith, and salvation. A sketch, with 2 men named Bob telling the story of the Ethiopian Eunuch. 9. Sharing the News: themes of sharing faith, family. A modern drama about 2 young arctic explorer brothers who refuse to share. The older brother makes an exciting discovery. Will he tell his brother about it? 10. Trouble at the Lab: themes of getting along, sibling rivalry, family. The 2 young arctic explorer brothers still can't share! They fight over the use of their equipment. There must be a better way!

VD308 **TACKLING TOUGH QUESTIONS [DVD]**

Thinking deeply about God, evil, suffering and death, this is a teaching and learning pack for use with 14-19 year olds.
