



TRAVEL AND PARKING INFORMATION FOR 4TH JULY

WHERE IS GLOUCESTER PARK?

The Park is situated along Trier Way, between Southgate Street and Park Road.
The Robert Raikes statue is situated near Park Road, approximately opposite Wellington Road.

Parking

We recommend using the park and ride service.

Buses leave every twelve minutes from St. Oswald's [adjacent to large BandQ on St. Oswald's way] or from Waterwells, [situated off A38 coming from M5].

The Park and ride stops at the new Gloucester Quays development.

It is an easy walk from there into the park. Simply cross Southgate Street into Trier Way, and on the left there is a footpath into the Park.

There are many multi-story car parks in Gloucester but to park for the day will cost £10 per vehicle.

A cheaper alternative is available at Severn Road [off the new A430 by-pass] for £2 all day. It is a 15 minute walk to the Park from here.

Disabled spaces and spaces for vehicles with 7 or more passengers are available **free** at King's School
