Off The Shelf from the Diocese of Blackburn

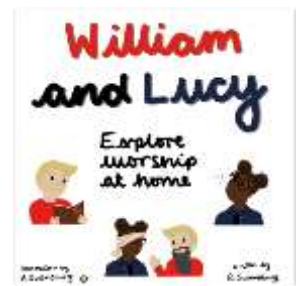

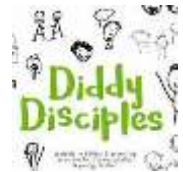
