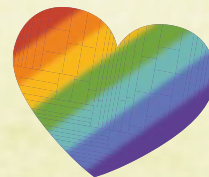


Hearts of Love for February

letterbox

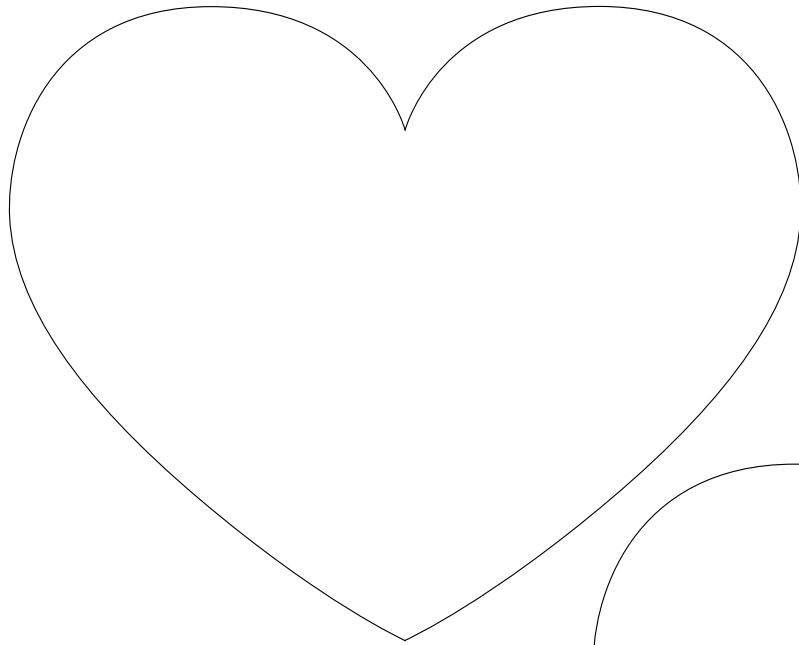
